What are phonics?

Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate sounds or 'phonemes'. They are then taught how to blend these sounds together to read the whole word.

- Children have a discrete 20/30 minutes phonics lesson every day at school and a 20-minute guided reading lesson every day.
- They are encouraged to use the strategies taught in other lessons.

Why are the children being screened?


- Every Year 1 child in the country normally takes the phonics screening check in the same 2 week window in June.
- The aim of the check is to ensure that all children are able to read by the end of Year 2.



Why?

Why are the children being screened?

- If children don't pass the screening check, it will enable us to give them more support and they will take the screening check again in June 2026.
- We have to report your child's results to you before the end of the Summer Term.
- We have to tell the Local Authority the results for our school.



Why?

What do the children have to do?

- The check is very similar to tasks the children have already completed in Year 1.
- Children will be asked to 'sound out' a word and blend the sounds together e.g. d-o-g – dog.
- The focus of the check is to see which sounds the children know.
- The children will also be asked to read made up 'nonsense' words so that children who have a good sight vocabulary can be fairly assessed.

The Phonics Check

- The phonics screening check is not a READING test. It is a DECODING test. It is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. It will identify pupils who need extra help to improve their decoding skills.
- The check consists of 20 real words and 20 pseudo-words that a pupil reads aloud to the teacher.
- It takes about 5-10 minutes
