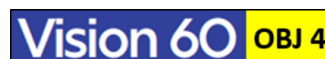

Bidding opened on Friday 7th June and will close on Friday 28th June.

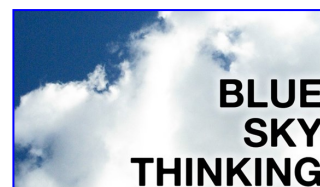
