WOODRIDGE TEST RESULTS 2023

Below you will see a table of all the national tests results for last year at Woodridge. As you will see, Woodridge children scored above National or Barnet averages in almost all areas, with significantly above average scores in maths, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and at a higher standard/greater depth.

National scores only become available in some tests during October/November, so these scores are compared to the Barnet averages for 2023.

Congratulations to all the children and staff for an excellent set of results.

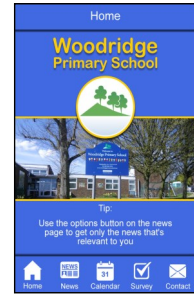
